Supply Our Schools is a 501(c)3 based in Reston, VA that uses the concept of online gift registries to perfectly match donors to teachers all across the US. The process is simple:

- Any Teacher in a US Public School can set up a Supply List of items they need for their classroom.
- Any Donor can buy, through a secure PayPal transaction, whatever supplies they want for any teacher they want. SOS sends the supplies directly to the teacher's school.
- Once the teacher gets the supplies, they enter the receipt date and thank you notes from their students. These notes are available for the Donor to see.
